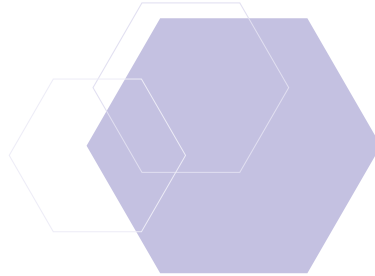

Audiometry courses

We provide a two-day assessed competency course based on a recommended syllabus of the British Society of Audiology (BSA) and the Health & Safety Executive (HSE).

We also offer a one-day refresher course for professionals looking to update their skills and knowledge as required.

Spirometry courses

A practical one-and-a-half-day competency course providing theoretical, practical and interpretational skills in conducting respiratory tests within an occupational health environment.

As well as a one-day refresher course for individuals who require a refresher in all aspects of occupational spirometry measurements and interpretation.

Vision courses

A comprehensive one-day course incorporating all theoretical and practical aspects of industrial vision screening programmes.

The course includes vision requirements, screening tests, results analysis, and potential hazards in the workplace.

Our courses are independently accredited and registered to provide delegates with Continuing Professional Development (CPD).

Audiometry

We have developed a range of accredited occupational audiometry screening courses focused specifically for occupational health and primary care professionals.

Our occupational audiometry courses are based on the recommended syllabus by the British Society of Audiology (BSA), and have been further developed with the Health and Safety Executive's (HSE) Control of Noise at Work regulations (2021), together with industry-specific requirements and occupational health specialists.

Two-day competency course

Introducing the principles of a hearing conservation programme in the workplace, the two-day competency course provides the knowledge and practical skills required to be proficient in carrying out screening audiometry, evaluation and categorisation of test results.

One-day refresher course

Our one-day audiometry refresher course is a theory and practical course, designed for occupational health professionals who require a general updating of their skills and knowledge to complete screening audiometry in the workplace to the highest standard.

Course content includes:

- Basic acoustics
- Anatomy and physiology
- Physical Agents (noise) Directive
- Factors affecting test accuracy
- Otoscopy
- Techniques of AC audiometry
- Audiogram interpretation
- HSE Categorisation

Spirometry

Our spirometry courses have been designed to develop theoretical, practical and interpretational skills in order to conduct respiratory testing within an occupational health environment.

We offer competency based and refresher level training for both new and existing occupational healthcare professionals within all aspects of spirometry.

One-and-a-half-day competency course

A complete and comprehensive spirometry course intended for OH trained individuals who have experience of spirometry measurements and who require competency-based assessment to conduct lung function measurements.

The course focuses on theoretical and practical aspects of spirometry measurements and the interpretation of pulmonary function test results. Includes a written and practical examination based on course content learnt on day one.

One-day refresher course

Our one-day occupational spirometry refresher course is the perfect add-on for occupational health professionals who require an annual update or refresher training in all aspects of occupational spirometry measurements and interpretation.

The course is ideal for individuals who have already taken the one-and-a-half-day competency course or currently conduct spirometry in the workplace and are looking to keep up to date with the latest standards and best practice in lung health.

Course content includes:

- Anatomy of the respiratory system
- Spirometry protocols
- Hygiene and infection control
- Calibration requirements and practical session
- Consistency of measurements
- Factors that can cause measurement errors
- Peak flow meters & practical session
- Interpretation and practical session
- Written assessment (competency course only)

Vision

The challenge many occupational health professionals face is that there are few national standards, with a tendency for vision assessments to be occupation specific.

This comprehensive one-day vision screening training course is designed to offer education and training for occupational healthcare professionals who are conducting or intending to conduct vision screening in the workplace.

The course aims to incorporate many of the occupation specific assessments, including both theoretical and practical aspects. The course includes vision requirements, eye examinations, vision test parameters, results analysis and hazards in the work environment.

The objectives of the course are to provide delegates with the knowledge to detect individuals with visual disorders including those with visual acuity, depth perception and colour difficulties. The course will also provide delegates with the knowledge to identify individuals in need of referral for a more comprehensive eye examination.

- Colour vision testing
